Explanation of Our Services

Coordinating Activities

Professional consultation with licensed personnel, which may include, but is not limited to, expert advice on options to meet your needs, including essential services relating to disposition, drafting notices, planning, scheduling of services, advice regarding possible government benefits. May include, but not limited to, co-ordination of all rites and ceremonies, before, during, and after they have been provided, including services and supplies provided by us, as well as those provided by third party suppliers, such as flowers and death notices by an Ontario Funeral Directors Licensee. Fees also include standard register book for guests to sign, standard acknowledgement cards, and aftercare.

Documentation

Completion and filing of all documents necessary to carry out the services and supplies requested, including, but not limited to, death registration, burial permit, coroner's certificate for cremation, or documentation to ship the body out of the country. As part of this service, we will provide you with 10 proof of death certificates. Such certificates are usually accepted for most estate settlement purposes, but sometimes a provincial Death Certificate will be necessary and is available from the Office of the Registrar General.

Embalming (Requires Facilities for Shelter/Prepare)

Embalming is the process of replacing blood and bodily fluids with chemical preservatives. It is a process of sanitation, restoration, and temporary preservation. Embalming is not legally required unless being shipped outside of the province/country, but may be recommended to preserve the body between the time of death and the visitation or disposition of the deceased. Our professional Funeral Directors will make a recommendation based on the condition of the body and expected service needs.

Staff Services for Visitation

Staff to coordinate and oversee the visitation. Additional cost is \$160.00 per hour. For off-site visitations, an additional staff fee will apply in lieu of facility, equivalent to the facility fee in the package.

Staff Services for Ceremony

Staff to coordinate and oversee the ceremony. For off-site ceremonies, an additional staff fee will apply in lieu of facility, equivalent to the facility fee in the package.

Facilities for Shelter/Prepare

Temperature controlled facilities used to prepare, embalm, and/or shelter the decedent; this charge applies whenever the decedent is in our facility for any purpose.

Facilities for Visitation (Requires Staff for Visitation)

Designated facilities used for a visitation. Additional Cost is \$180.00 per hour.

Facilities for Ceremony (Requires Staff for Ceremony)

Designated facilities used for a ceremony.

Transfer of Remains

Vehicle for transfer from place of death and/or to the crematorium. Additional mileage is added at a rate of \$2.50/km after 25km one way.

Lead Car/General Duties Car

Vehicle for transporting clergy, leading funeral procession and/or obtaining required documentation.

Funeral Coach

Vehicle for transporting casket to place of worship, cemetery, etc. Additional mileage is added at a rate of \$2.50/km after 25km one way.

Basic Preparation

Charged when the decedent is to be dressed/washed/hair styled/shaved. This is included in Embalming.

The Science

Parting Stone® Solidified Remains

Step 1: Refinement

We remove foreign contaminants like staples and screws from the cremated remains. The granule "ash" is refined into a powder.

Step 2: Stone Forming

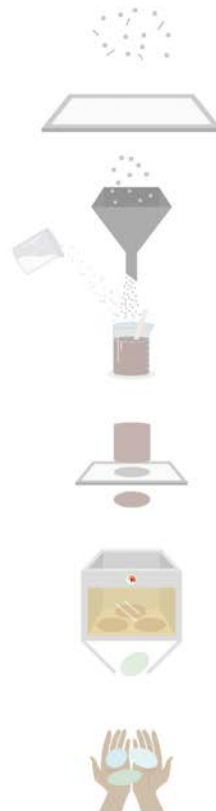
A small amount of binder is added to the ash, the remains are mixed into a clay-like material, and the stones are formed.

Step 3: Solidification

The stones are heated in a kiln giving the solidified remains their hardness and permanence.

Step 4: Return Home

Finished solidified remains are cleaned and polished. Your stones are ready to come home and be shared with family and friends.



Takes about 10-14 weeks to complete.

Support Programs

Community Grief Support Groups



These weekly Grief Support Groups are held each Tuesday, September through June, at 9:30 a.m. – 11:30 a.m. OR 7:00 p.m. – 9:00 p.m.

This time offers you an opportunity to meet with a professional grief counsellor and others in a caring and confidential environment. This provides a safe place for you to come and share, listen and receive support through your grieving journey. Each week has a discussion topic, and resources are often available for additional support. Anyone who has suffered a loss, who feels they would benefit from these sessions, is welcome to attend. These sessions are held at the Cattel Centre (the beige house beside the Funeral Home at 45 Main Street), and full funding for this program is provided by the Turner Family Funeral Home. The facilitator of this group is Beverley Yates. She is the Manager of the Spiritual Care at St. Joseph's Villa in Dundas, where she has journeyed with Residents and their families for over 25 years, offering support through difficult times. Along with certificates in Counselling, Palliative Care. Death/Dying & Bereavement Education and training in Critical Incident Stress Management, she brings a passion and warm love for people as they work through some of the challenges of grief.

Aftercare



Caring about our families doesn't end on the day of the funeral. We know this can be an overwhelming time and there are things that need to be addressed within a period of time. That's why we provide, free of charge, aftercare with our aftercare Specialist, Jane Hartwell, to assist you with many of the tasks that must be dealt with.

Payment, Financing and Funding

For Services at Time of Death:

Payment is due within 30 days of signing the contract, beyond which interest will be charged at a rate of 1.5%, which is equivalent to 18% per annum (APR). Payment may be made by cash, cheque, debit, and most major credit cards. Payment plans are also available to meet most budgets. Financing charges apply to payment plans. Financial assistance for funeral, burial, cremation / hydrolysis services is available through various governmental agencies, to those who qualify. Cash Disbursements are due upon signing the contract. A 5% discount on Funeral Home Services and Supplies will apply to those who pay in full for all outstanding services at time of signing the contract.

Pre-Payment in Advance of Need:

For services that are being arranged pre-need, we offer funding options when prepaying services or supplies:

Trust: You pay for the services and supplies at today's price and we will place your money in a trust account, where it will accrue interest until the prepaid contract is fulfilled (when the services and supplies are delivered). Pre-payment can be made by cheque or credit. Funds are held in the purchaser's name.

When paid in full in accordance with the payment terms set out in the prepaid contract, the prepaid contract is guaranteed. The total payment(s) made plus interest / growth earned will be applied to the future price of the services and supplies. If the total payment(s) plus interest / growth earned are insufficient to cover the total future price of the prepaid services and supplies, we will absorb the difference as a loss. Any funds in excess of the total future price of the prepaid services and supplies will be returned or applied toward additional services, supplies and disbursements purchased at the time of need, as applicable. Conditions apply. Any changes to the prepaid contract may result in the prepaid contract being null and void and a new contract being executed with current pricing at the time changes are made.
